Fukuoka Airport → Fukuoka City Subway JR Chikuhi Line → Karatsu Station (Approx. 70 min.)

Karatsu yakimon festival

From April 29 (national holiday) to May 5 (national holiday) each year, visitors can enjoy Karatsu Ware pottery for seven days, including exhibitions of new works by Karatsu Ware artists, exhibitions and sales events in town, and collaborative events between Karatsu Ware and restaurants.

Karatsu pottery tourism

For two days on Saturday and Sunday in late November each year, Karatsu Ware artists will entertain visitors at their potteries. During these two days, you can enjoy workshop tours, gallery tours, and discussions with the potters about Karatsu Ware.

Learn how to decorate your space with Karatsu Ware from a hospitality professional.

Karatsu Ware is a part of our daily life. The materials, methods of production, and finishes of the works vary greatly. How can we make the most of the whole spectrum of Karatsu Ware's charms in a room? Accommodation facilities such as inns and hotels can teach us that. Notice the vases decorating the entrance, the flower vases and furnishings in the alcove, and the vessels served during meals and tea ceremonies. Some facilities also have gallery spaces where works by notable artists are exhibited.

Karatsu Ware is a "Beauty of Use" That is perfected by the user.

Karatsu Ware is made of rough, coarse clay. It has a simple yet powerful appearance that has won the hearts of many tea masters, and has long been praised as "Ichiido, Niraku, Sankaratsu" in the ranking of matcha bowls ("Ido Ware is the best, Raku Ware is the second best and Karatsu Ware is the third best").

There are various theories about the origin of Karatsu Ware but it seems that it was already being made in the Kitahata area at the foot of Mt. Kishidake during the late Muromachi period and the Momoyama period. The production of Karatsu Ware increased-

when potters from Korea brought techniques such as "nobori-gama" and "kerokuro" to Karatsu. After the introduction of iron painting decorations, the variety as well as volume of the production increased.

Karatsu Ware is a "Beauty of Use" meaning that it is on display only when it is used. As the saying goes, "Its value depends 80 percent on the makers, 20 percent on the users." It is complete only after the tea is made, the food is served, and the flowers are arranged. We hope you will create your own complete Karatsu Ware, which reflects your individuality.

People who make Karatsu Ware.

Today, there are as many as 70 potteries scattered throughout the city of Karatsu. Each pottery has created its own unique style, inheriting the techniques of its predecessors cultivated over its long history and incorporating new sensibilities. The variety of expression fostered through tradition and innovation is indeed the appeal of Karatsu Ware, which has fans around the world. We suggest you visit the exhibition halls, stores, and galleries in the city to experience the thoughts and expressions of each potter.
