Built in 1866, this residence belonged to Oshima, a samurai who worked with American and British merchants, and a right to sail.

Former Takatori Residence (旧滝塔邸)

Kawamura Art Museum (川村美術館)

Karatsu Castle (Castle Tower) (唐津城)  
The symbol of the region, Karatsu Castle, was built in 1587. The main tower of the castle was completed in 1597. The castle was destroyed by fire in 1863.

Nijnomatubara Pine Grove (新井野松林)  
One of Karatsu's most beautiful spots is the pine grove. This grove is a remnant of Japanese black pine trees that were planted in the area in the 19th century.

Former Karatsu Bank (旧唐津銀行)
